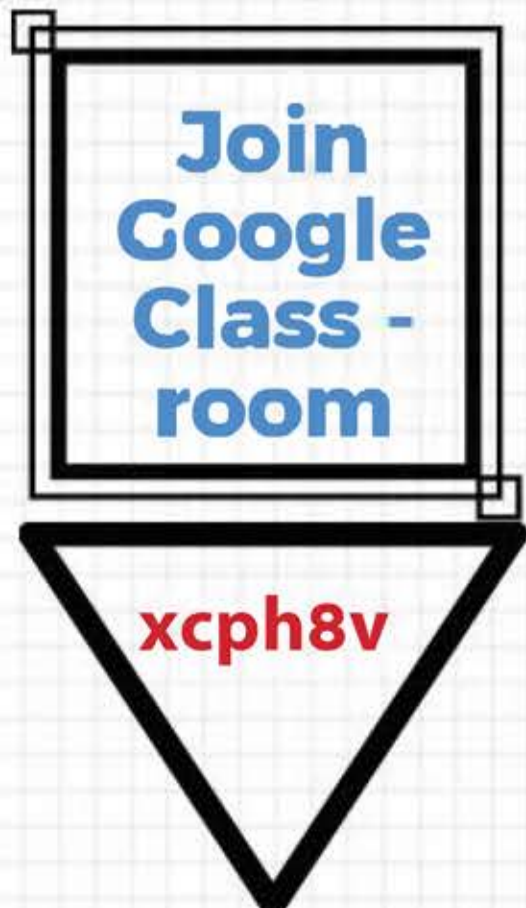
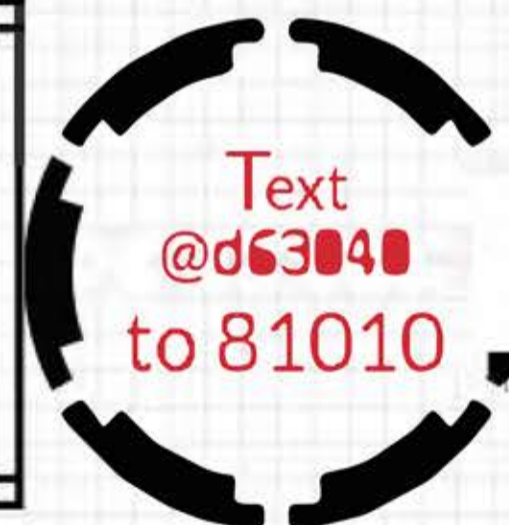

## What will we need?
