## **Materials Fee**

There is a \$50 materials fee for each semester. Under state law a public education is free of charge, but one exception applies to this course. Specifically, state law allows the school to charge students for the direct cost of materials provided to students to make/create personal property for their own possession and use. For this course, the cost of the materials that will be provided is \$50/semester. We ask that this amount be paid on or before August 29th, 2019. The fees cover film and photographic paper as well as chemicals required to process the photographs for first semester and the second semester additional \$50 goes toward photographic inks and photographic printer paper. These materials are very expensive and would cost more to purchase individually, so I buy the items in bulk once the material fees are in to get your students the most materials for the least amount of money.

You can pay one fee of \$100 for the entire year or \$50 each semester. You can submit cash or a check made out to TOHS.
