- A JOURNAL HAS TWO PARTS WHEN WE USE DIGITAL

- A PLAN
- REFLECTION

WHAT IS A PLAN?

- **BEFORE** YOU EVER SHOOT, THINK, BRAINSTORM, DRAW, LIST, COMPILE, DO WHATEVER YOU CAN, TO CREATE IDEAS. SOMETIMES OUR FIRST IDEAS ARE THE BEST, SOMETIMES THEY ARE NOT.

WHAT IS A REFLECTION?

- A REFLECTION IS WHEN YOU RECORD YOUR THOUGHTS ON YOUR PROCESS FOR EACH PROJECT. IT IS NOT WRITING ABOUT EACH INDIVIDUAL PHOTO. YOU MAY TELL ABOUT WHAT WENT WELL, WHAT PROBLEMS YOU HAD, WHAT SUCCESSES OR CHALLENGES YOU ENCOUNTERED, QUESTIONS YOU HAVE, CONFUSION OR UNDERSTANDING THAT AROSE...
- THERE IS NO REQUIRED LENGTH
- THIS MUST BE COMPLETED BEFORE YOU TURN IN YOUR WORK, NOT AS I AM COLLECTING IT.

MOUNTED PHOTOS

YOU CAN MOUNT YOUR PHOTOS ON:

- CONSTRUCTION PAPER
- CARD STOCK
- CARDBOARD
- FOAM CORE
- MATTE BOARD

YOU SHOULD USE RUBBER CEMENT, SPRAY ADHESIVE, OR ACID-FREE GLUE STICK,
NOT WET WHITE GLUE

WHEN YOU BRING UP YOUR ASSIGNMENT TO BE GRADED, BRING UP YOUR GRADE SHEET TOO

- IF YOU CANNOT FIND YOUR GRADE SHEET, YOU CAN PRINT OUT A NEW ONE AT TOHSPHOTOGRAPHY.WEEBLY.COM ON THE SEMESTER II TAB AND CLICK ON THE FIRST BUTTON AT THE INTRO OF THAT PAGE
